

Host Family Time

International students are expected to generally follow host family routines as well as balance their time between their host family and their friends.

Activity Requests

It is expected that students **ASK** permission **BEFORE** doing any activity with both with friends or on their own.

Denying Requests

Host parents have the right to deny a student request if the activity is unsafe, unreasonable, against program rules, or there is another reason for concern.

Students are discouraged from being "downtown" after dark.

Social gatherings in homes without appropriate supervision is prohibited.

Before giving approval for all sleepover requests host parents must confirm that there will be an approved by ISP adult supervisor that is 25+ years with CRC completed. NOTE: Opposite sex in attendance is prohibited.



GUIDELINES

STUDENT REQUESTS FOR SOCIAL ACTIVITIES



Information Needed

When making a request, students need to provide all details and information to their host parent including:

1. The planned activities.
2. Where they will be.
3. Who they will be with.
4. The transportation plan to get to the activity and back home.

Student Check-In

It is reasonable for a host parent to check-in periodically with their student if their student is out of the home socially for an extended period of time.

Students are expected to answer all messages/calls from their host parents and any Program staff.

Curfew

It is expected that all students follow the Program curfew as outlined. The Program should be notified if a student is regularly late for curfew.

Program Contacts
